

A+ Recognition Scholarships at Four year schools

The following four-year colleges/universities offer A+ scholarships not funded by the state of Missouri. These scholarships are competitive and the A+ Senior needs to apply for these early. Please contact the college or check the internet for more information. Deadlines, and scholarship details may change, please check the website for updates.

The list below may be incomplete, contact individual colleges to inquire about A+ Scholarships and awards. All awards are based upon meeting requirements of the A+ program.

Avila University	\$1000 annually awarded to full time, first year students who successfully complete the A+ Program. http://www.avila.edu/financialaid/scholarships.asp
Central Methodist College	Any student who has completed the A+ program is eligible for $\frac{1}{2}$ tuition scholarship. http://www.centralmethodist.edu/finaid/scholarships.php
Columbia College	Awarded up to \$2500 to new freshman, who have completed the Missouri A+ program http://www.ccis.edu/offices/financialaid/scholarshipfinder/FreshmanScholarships-categorized.asp
Culver Stockton	They offer a \$1500 scholarship for students who participate in the A+ program. For more information contact admissions http://www.culver.edu/enrollment/finaid/scholarships/freshman.asp
Drury University	Any student who has completed the A+ program is eligible for a \$1,000 annual award as a freshman. It is renewable with a 3.0 cumulative GPA. Application deadline is Jan 10. http://www.drury.edu/multinl/story.cfm?ID=11864&NLID=28#APlus
Evangel University	This \$1,000 renewable scholarship is offered for selected students who have completed the Missouri A+ Schools Program. A scholarship committee may select up to 30 applicants to receive this award. It is renewable with a 3.0 Cumulative GPA. Fontbonne University	Any student attending an A+ high school who completes the Missouri requirements for that program may be eligible for \$1,000 in additional scholarship funds. http://www.fontbonne.edu/admissions/undergraduate/firsttimefreshmen/payingforschool/scholarships/
Missouri State University	This \$500 per year renewable scholarship is offered to 100 students. To qualify you must meet A+ Program requirements, apply for admission by January 15, and apply for the A+ Recognition Scholarship Application. http://www.missouristate.edu/assets/financialaid/APlusRecognitionApp.pdf
Missouri Southern State University	\$1000 per academic year (limit of 100) to A+ qualifier enrolled full time. The scholarship cannot be combined with other MSSU academic scholarships. It is renewable up to eight semesters with a 3.0 GPA. http://www.mssu.edu/financial-aid/forms/aplusscholarship.pdf
Missouri Western State University	This competitive scholarship is awarded to students who elect to enroll in a four-year degree program and who have a 3.00 GPA. This scholarship is

Missouri Valley College	<p>Any student who has completed the A+ program is eligible for ½ tuition scholarship. The student must be a first year entering resident student that meets admission requirements.</p> <p>http://www.moval.edu/financial_aid/scholarships.php</p>
Northwest Missouri State	<p>A limited number of scholarships are available for \$1500 to A+ qualifiers. Contact admission for question. It is renewable for one year by completing 24 credit hours with a GPA of 3.30.</p> <p>http://www.nwmissouri.edu/FinAid/scholarships/index.htm</p>
Park University	<p>\$5000 tuition off for any A+ qualifier (Must provide a letter of eligibility from HS) who has a 3.25 GPA or 24 on the ACT and completes the scholarship application. It is renewable for a maximum of four years with a GPA of 3.25 and the student must complete 24 credit hours each academic year (Fall and Spring).</p>
